(Creek)--I never did pay any attention (Creek). I don't know what it is (Creek). It must be something like psychology. If a man knows anything about psychology, he can work the mind-- Like my sister, Hazel, her and I can work our minds together (Creek). I don't know what it is, but I just had to call you (Creek). I said to Martha, "I know what it is," I said (Creek). Really, I just never did know what it is. Well, it is interesting. Witchcraft (Creek), in Bible times it's mentioned. That's the way I believe. I may be wrong. I never did see one. I don't think I want to see. (Creek).
