and one belonging to John Hargrove the Hargrove horse won. A rematch was made and the Hargrove horse lost. The loss so affected Hargrove that he killed himself.

To preserve something of the past, Dr. Gunter had a painting made of the old Gunter home several years ago as it looked when it was occupied and well maintained. A story plate on the frame of the painting reads, "The Gunter Home, Hi-go, Arkansas. The original brick home built by Caldeen Gunter in 1853. Destroyed by fire during the Civil War. Some of the brick and stone were salvaged and used in rebuilding the second home, as were some of the timbers."
