TOPICS DISCUSSED:

SINCE THE ENTIRE TAPE DEALS WITH THE APACHE GHOST DANCE  
NO DIVISIONS HAVE BEEN MADE.

BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

Louise Saddleblanket is nearly full-blooded Apache, 74 years  
old, with a maximum schooling of about six years (although she  
remained for several of these years in the same grade.) She has  
been married at least three times and has born unnumerable children,  
although only three have survived to the present time. She is  
highly knowledgeable about the old days and is an articulate in-  
formant.
