BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

Annie Bigman was born in 1900 at Mountain View, Oklahoma. She moved to Carnegie when she was about one year old. Annie is married to Fred Bigman, an Apache and they now live in Anadarko. She attended Rainy Mountain Indian Boarding school for four years, starting when she was four years of age and completed high school at Bacone College at Muskogee. Annie Bigman's maiden name was Annie Sampty.
