I took music lessons there too. Piano. (Do you play now?) Yea. Wé had a music teacher. (Were all of the teachers women?) Yea. (Were they all white?)* Yea. (Were all of the students Indian?) Um-uhm (Yes) (What tribes die they students represent?) Choctaw, and Creek, and Seminoles, Kiowas, and Comanches, Cheyennes, 'and Arapahos. No Apaches. (1What language did most of the students speak?) English. (Did they speak this to each other?) Wh-hum. (Yes.) (Did they ever talk in their native languages?) No -(Did you know how to write English before you came?)
