And in closing again, I would like to say that he will long be remembered in the annals of Osage history of what he has done and what his association with people other than our tribe. And what good deeds he has done for them--and--just like when Mr. Echo Hawk prepared that scroll for Mr. Boots Adams. He generally charges a pretty good fee, but he said that Mr. Pitts and he would do it just for me if Paul wanted it, that Paul had done a lot for the Pawnee Tribe and therefore it would be an honor for him just to do it for him and would not charge him a thing. And it was just one of the things that how people---
