That's the way it is.

### HAND GAME EQUIPMENT

(You were talking about this bean they had in their hand?)

Yeah.

(Did they use beans?)

They got beaded ones. They got beaded beans. Some of them is round. Little round things. But these, they're about that long, and they're beaded. One man is got black and blue. And the black goes on the south side and the blue on that side. Then there's a blue and red. And red goes on the south and the blue goes on the north. And now then they got these big bones--you know, them long bones--(Hair pipes) and they put a black band on one. That's the main bean. But you have to play both of them. And when they guess, if you got that with the band, well, they find you. That's the way they play.

(But back there, if you were being guessed--you would just have one bean?)

Just one.

(And then try to guess which hand it's in?)

Yeah. It's like hiding a button. (Button-button-who's got the button)

Yeah, if they find the bean on which hand they're guess, they take it. And then they go get it over there on their side. That's the way it is.

(And what if they don't find it--what happens?)

They just keep playing until they find it. They just have to keep guessing you. Till they find the bean. And if you get all these sticks before they find the bean, why that's a game.

(How many sticks are there?)

Oh, seven on each side. Fourteen all together. Seven--six sticks, and this stick they guess with. There's one that's longer than the others,
