ask them.

(Did they wrap their own braids?)

Yeah, they wrapped their own braids themselves.

(Did they decorate their hair in any way when they had their braids?)

Yeah. They either put those bands around their hair and up here.

(At base or tip of braids)

(Were the Comanches here before the Kiowa?)

Yeah, the Comanches were here before.

(Your husband was telling me something about that. He said you would know.)

Yeah, the Comanches ..some of the old peoples that went north. And they

found them...find these Kiowas. And that's when they brought them

down here. They didn't exactly bring them but they told them where they

live. For a long time, they never did go back and see them. And then

they come in....they come in here where the Indians were. The
