GUY QUOTONE, KIOWA  
GENEALOGICAL INFORMATION COLLECTED

This manuscript is a summary of the information contained on Tapes 145-650. This is a genealogy of Guy Quotone collected during several interviews in April of 1971. It is not exhaustive, though the main outlines are mostly filled in. There are some gaps in the lines of descent of Guy's mother's relatives--her collaterals and their descendants. Also, no attempt was made to chart Guy's affinal relatives through either of his wives. There is some confusion regarding the descendants of Zetieh, No. 22.

Guy was married twice. His first wife was the mother of his children. When she died he later married Nellie Harpe. Nellie's children by her first husband were also Guy's blood relations as shown on Chart 1. Thus they are both his step-children and his nieces and nephews.

The tapes contain other miscellaneous bits of information pertaining to Kiowa kinship terminology and behavior, and the history of some Kiowa family names and how they were changed by being Anglicized. There is no complete kinship schedule, however, and time did not permit the complete transcription of the material.
