eat. But the house looks like a barn. (Oh-h.)

When we get our new house I hope to have more room and little more space for everything. Maybe I'll be better housekeeper. (Yeah, you probably will.)

I was telling one of the girls the other day. My mother always said, "When you make cornbread, you know, stir it up in this brown pan. Always, you know when you empty the batter out into your bread pan to bake, always wash this pan right then. Don't let it dry. Rinse it out at least. Then get it ready to be washed. But rinse all the cornmeal out and then it won't get in your dish water. If you do that, you'll be a good house-keeper." I said, "I tried that for years and years and didn't improve my housekeeping at all. Every time I make cornbread I think about that. (Laughter)

(Yeah.)

"Rinse your pan out first."
(Discussion between child and informant--)
