(Well, you remember that we were talking about the way people danced in the Ghost Dance and you said that they went around circles?)

Yes, they went around in circles.

(Is there any particular direction that they go?)

Yes, they around to the left.

(To the left?)

Uhuh.

(Do they always go around to the left?)

They always did that I know of.

(Do they always use the same step?)

Yes, always the same..I think there's two or three different steps depending on the song. Most of the old songs, well they're all mostly in 4/4 music time and maybe once in a while it's 3/4. Or something like that. Speaking music, you'd have to say alagrato so that you mean fast.

(What step do you do then when the music changes like that?)
