... to the adoption of the Ghost Dance. This was during the Delaware doings. It was right down here at my grandma's and there was a woman..my grand uncle Jack Thomas had a new set of harness and I guess this woman went and took off the harness and put them under her pillow, thinking that nobody would know, but Uncle Jack Thomas happened to be a member of this society (Ghost Dance) or whatever you want to call it. He pulled out his black handkerchief and stated what was wrong. He didn't want to hurt anybody, and so when they were getting ready to go, so he came around the fire, which was always made of flint, that's what we used, and he came in and went around the fire and he unfolded that handkerchief and it just went straight uh.. I was there as a child and I saw it. I thought it was rather odd then, and that handkerchif unfurled just like/a stick and it rolled and he went around the fire and he went over to where that woman was sitting and it hit her on the head just like that and it indicated that she was the guilty one. Now that comes in on that stolen property and then when they, the theives, if they wanted to recover all that property that was stolen, or the stolen stock or whatever it was, all they had to use was their power. And then you'd hear the herd coming in at night. By some blessed means, they'd come in and return all that stock. And they'd get them all back. (Were there special people that did this?) Oh yea, that's why I say they had prophets in that and you could go and ask them anything that .. or otherwise I wouldn't be sitting here

to/tell you because that's how I was cured from polio.
