It's 4/5 in C#. That's pretty high, but I guess it goes.

See that's the eagle has come and we'll see him today and there he is in the crowd. See that's what it says. That's why I had that old book out.

(Does anyone make up new songs today?)

No, not that I know of. We just use the old songs because there's plenty of them. Hundreds of them.

(How do you learn these songs?)

Just verbally. You hear them, this first song, that's ar old song. I never did hear it but I just picked it out of the book. If you know your music you can go ahead and pick it out.

(Did anyone ever sing these songs to you?)

Mother use to sing them. There's a lot of people that sings them that didn't even belong to that. It's just a common song. Just like you would sing Tipperary.

(Did people pray in the Ghost Dance a long time ago?)

Why sure. That was the main thing.

(When did they pray?)

Well, it's always an invocation just before they start. In fact, all our rituals are started with an invocation.

(Would they pray while the dance was going too?)

Well, they may have been some, but of course, you couldn't hear them.

(Did they pray for any certain things?)

I suppose they did but as I say, I didn't belong to that so I wouldn't know.

(Do you remember of people ever talking and saying they saw a Ghost during the

Well, in fact 'I don't think that Caddos believe in ghosts at all. lThey belive in spirits.

(Well did they ever see any of these spiritx?)

Ghost Dance or something like that?)

So they say that they did but I don't know what significance was. That's what I always heard. I always listened to a lot of them. Of course at that time I didn't
