Apl they're paying is their utilitfes. That's where we live. We just pay dur utilities. Cause we own the Iot, see. And then I bought the 50 by 50 apd I cannot build a home because it ddesn!'t have that much loan value on it (see Tape 60.5 for more on this):

Jordan: Could you put a trailer house or somefhing like thati on there? 'Irene: I guess we could put a trailer home in there, but the wind would come and throw. it way out in the bushes.

Roberta: That's what I was thinking. See, the even give loans for the Caddoes up that way., And they got the trailer homes. Did you see them pictures? on the builetin board, they got new trafier homes over there. or either they're remodelling the old homes or either bulding new homes. Now they got their business done I don't know how Ipng it's been going on, you know. But us over here, we 'Just can't get-startad.
Irene: It's, our committeemans--they, just won'd get together. They cannot get together.
Jordan; Weli, if you do' get plackie and Elton's pplications approved for new homes--

Irene: They're all ready: All they need is the land.
Jordan: Do they have any cheice in what. kind of a pouse they get?
Irene: Yes. . I think Blackie hals a four bedroom with the children.
Birdie: Are they gonaa all be built the same, or are they gonaa build them different?
