(You know, I was gonna ask you a while ago, and I forgot to. You know back-- back when those clans come down through the family tree, you know. What did they call each one of them on each side?)

What you mean?

(Just like if you lived way back there, what did you call your son. Say you had three sons, what did they call them three sons, or three daughters and grandchildren and all that?)

You know that is what I was telling you a while ago. Each one got own name.

If you are a deer clan, your father and mother--your father knows what's the name come call the first name and name for the second and got name for the third, and on down the line. I don't know what part where (not clear) or not.

I don't know what name your father gave you, but that is your name. The next one is some part of the body. And if you are a deer clan, sometime they call (Osage name); meaning deer feet.
