(Ah-huh) And that was two story, too. And there was a long porch there on front end from one end to the other and had bannister on it. (Hum! I bet that was a pretty place wasn't it?) It was! It was a pretty place. And the spring, was northwest of the house, of the kitchen part of it. Just a little down there. (That country, must of had some clearing there compared, to what it is now, it's all growed up in brush and timber, now.) Well. (Was the timber, there in the early days?). Pecan, pecan trees. Well, let's see, something else, I was gonna say. Sundays, were they around before McNairs. (Hum.) But the McNairs had all these two stories put on. (Yeah.) There was this little log house, there. (A-huh) And there was a pecan grove. (Hum! I bet that was a pretty place.) It was, it was a pretty place. (Well, did the main road come by their place, there, from the ferry?) Yeahl Come right by. (And that market ferry was right straight west, from the old house?) Ah-hum. Right straight west. My old home place where I was waise at, well we'll go over to this one first. (Yeah.) Any other questions you want to ask.
