this missionary come, come out, used to come out there and get us boys. I guess they had a meeting with the girls too. But we were boys, you know. And after we learned, after we went through that catachism, so many times, you know, we know it by heart. (Laughter) The priest would say "Who made you?" before he say, "Who" well, we'd say "God" (Laughter) Before he says it, they'd answer. They knew it by heart, you know. It's just like that. They used to teach us, memorize verses, you know. I forget what verse it was, you know, twenty-first Psalm, I believe, one of the Psaims, you know. Just like, well, we listen, you know. He'd read and we listen to him, try to pronounce those words just like he pronounced them. you know. Just like this one place, "But his delight is in the law." Yeah, that's the way it read now. He, and we, there was a boy there at the time. They're all gone. His name was Batiste Lodge, one of the Lodge boys. And his name is Batiste Lodge. And when he always come to that, "But He", BatisteLodge in the law. (Laughter) Seems like, that's the way it sounded like, to us. (Laughter) I used to, let's see, when he comes to that, we'd say "Batiste Lodge is in the law" But that's the way it sounded to us, but it reads, "But His delight is in the law." (Laughter) But that's the way it went. But we didn't know how to talk English, see? We didn't understand. That's the way it was back there. Another thing, I can't remember right now, but anyway, there's lots of things went on like that.
