Oh, they just always say--they just went under the water. Call it "lost tribe," that's all. (How would you say "lost tribe"--the Arapaho word for that?)

Well, I don't know how I would translate it--but they went under the water.

ARAPAHO NAMES FOR TRIBAL DIVISIONS

(What's the Arapaho name for themselves--what do the Arapahoes call

'themselves?)

hinwnuwinw

(Does that mean anything?)

It means "Arapaho."

(Does it mean anything else?)

No, it don't mean anything else.

(These northern Arapahoes--is there a name for that group?)

Let me tell you--they call these Wyoming Arapahoes--how would you say--

just Pike "red string man." bww.ciin en

(Is there any reason why they call them that?).

I don't know. / I don't know they call them that, but that's what they call them, bu S. ciin En

(Is there any other group of Arapahoes that you have a separate name for?) No. But these over here are Arapahoes. Them Wyomings (Arapahoes), they call us "southern Arapahoes"--nώω ww n i nin " they always call us. (or nuw wwn Ennw) -- "southern"--"southern Arapaho." That's means "southern man."

(This word that you call the northern Arapahoes, build ciin En, what does the build cii- mean?)
