You know what the Quaker Creed and how they supposed to be, you know.. Supposed to be a peaceful people. I think that was pretty good.)

Yes. They were good people. Friendly.

(That was about the only thing around in the 20's. What time did they come here--right after the war? You were in, or before you were in?)

Before I went in.

(Was it?)

Yeah.

(There was the war. You didn't go until about 1917, or was that when you went in?)

I went in about 19--I don't know if they were here or not--or was it 1917?

(But they certainly were here when you came back.

Huh?

(They were here when you came back?)

No, I don't believe--

(I mean Quaker were here, when you came back from the army.)
