and everything. Down in old town, Coweta.

(Well, old town Coweta why where was it from the main street to Coweta?)

West

(West.)

People use to come down here, for Indian medicine here. All along here.

You know people from up north come down here and dug it all up.

(Well)

That root that they take, if they vomit, you know.

(Yeah)

Red root. Boy it use to be thick in the sand hill.

(Yeah.' I think in Cherokee they call it pa-coon root. Ah'--)

We call it ah-woo-e-da.

(Yeah, ah-woo-e-da.)
