

waxu eiθi

(Now say the word that means "Greasy Leggings.")

caebin^ω.haed (Myrtle had told me in informal conversation that the Arapahoes living east of Geary along the Canadian used to be called "Greasy Leggings." --jj.)

(O.K. Now the word for "Fall-off-a-horse.")

caenisibeit (This term was applied to the Arapahoes around Colony--jj.)

(Once more.)

cae.nisibeitθi

(Did you ever hear of any reason why they had these kind of names for these people--like "Ugly-Faced People"?)

I don't know. Maybe there was a lot of ugly people up here (Canton district)--especially me! Yeah, they used to call them (Canton Arapahoes)

waxu eiθi

(What about the people living around Eagle City--would they have any special name for them?)

That's all waxu eiθi

(And Buffalo Mountain, too?)

Yeah.

(What about the people around Calumet--was there any name for them?)

Say, they used to just say "Small town." haecaeh^wwh^wω.wu

(That means "small town"?)

Yeah. And I think--I don't know what it means--but the Geary people, they used to call them w^usein^w.x -- w^usein^w.xhaebi -- That's Geary.

You might just as well put Watonga on there-- w^w'tae.n^wω.wu

(What does that mean?)

That means "black town." It was this--well, they couldn't pronounce it--
