(About how often did they have them?)
Oh, once in a while because they had to tratel in a wagon.
(What kind of dances did they have?)
Oh, just like this round dance and war dance. (Did they camp out at them?)

Yeah, they camp out like they know they camp out.
(Well, how lonc did they last?)
Oh, they dancer in the afternoor an then they wuld maybe quir at eleven. (How many days?)
