No, they don't do nothing, it always comes.

(Well, did they help the baby come?)

No, it comes itself that baby.

(He would come by himself?)

Um-hum.

(They didn't have any kind of medicine they would give you?)

No, no kind of medicine.

(Did anyone have any babies outside of their houses then?)

I don't know. I just douldn't tell you. Some of them had them in the house, but now days they go to the hospital, if your a young girl,

the hospital is good for you now days.

(Did they have any white doctors then?)

No.

(How far, was the closest one?)

The closest one was twelve miles from my house to Fort Cobb but we never sent for him.

(Did very many Indians use white doctors then?)

Yeah, some of them did, use white doctors. They had one doctor in Carnegie, and In Fort Cobb.

(Were they very good doctors?)

They did say they was a good doctor

(Well, did you have speical occassions for your baby like when you cut his hair the first time?)

Well, when they got long hair I cut it. I cut when some of them got long hair.
