No, they don't know who left them. And it's (cave) kinda on top of the mountain kind of a slant down, it's ah, the hole is big enough for a person's body to go in there, but they say after you get so far well that place get bigger and then inside, they say they got a big room.

(Where is this cave?)

By Long Horn Mountain. I just been on the outside. I never went inside but my oldest boy been in there, and my son-in-law's been in there several times.

(Is it still there now?)

It's still there. I just been as far as on top. I've seen it and I never been more than, farther on down I never did go in there. But my brother was the one that found that place. I've often wondered if it would be some outlaw place. There's a stream in that cave. They say that you can hear that water, that stream running and they can roll a small rock and it will roll for so long and they can just hear it where it hits that water, but where it's coming from nobody know, where that water is running but, below where, further on down where we used where we were all raised, there's a spring there, that's where my neice lives right now. She bought that place form us and she lives on that place. She was born there and she lives there now with a big home.

(What is your neice's name?)

Miss Morrison, Maggie Morrison. And ah, we just often wondered, my brother always did say that, he say that he figures that that's where that water is running down to that spring. It's just been a spring there far as I can remember but now it's modern. They got it fix and
