When I talking right to him or if he's close around I call his name and tell him "n 9 heic"

(What does that mean?)

It means "come here."

(Would you say that one again?)

n 9 heic

(Could you say b & hi 2 iihiin & nb 9 heic ?)

b hi inhiin nn 9 heir (laughs) You want to put that be heir in there-that's something nasty! (laugh)
