 And fourteen is yeni.ni ; And yw.owni.ni -- fifteen;
 ni.tw.tw.xu.ni -- sixteen; nis.w.tw.xu.ni -- seventeen;
 naes.w.tw.xu.ni -- eighteen; oi.w.tw.xu.ni -- nineteen;
 And twenty is nisw ; Twenty-one-- nisw.cae.se ini ;
 And then twenty-two is niswnisi.ni ;
 And twenty-three is nisw.nae.siini ; nisw.yeni.ni --twenty-four;
 And twenty-five is niswyw.owni.ni ; niswni.tw.tw.xu.ni --
 twenty-six; Twenty-seven is niswni.sw.tw.xu.ni

(How would you say "one horse"?)

Well, one horse would be ni.seti.w.w.x.w.

(How would you say "two horses"?)

ni.si.oi.w.w.x.w.haebi

(O.K. Say "three horses".)

haeh(ae)naeh(ae) i.oi.w.w.x.w.haebi ; And "four horses" is
 yeni.oi.w.w.x.w.haebi ; yw.owni.oi.w.w.x.w.haebi --five horses.

"Horse" is w.w.x.w. Just one horse is w.w.x.w. But two and
 three is w.w.x.w.haebi

(O.K. Say "my horse.")

nw.tw.nihi

(And "your horse.")

hw.tw.nihi

(And say "his horse.")

hit.w.nih.w

(*Their horse.")

hit.w.nihi.in.w.x

(Say "our horse.")

nw.tw.nihi.in.w

(And is there any other way, like "the two of them's horses--"?)
 That would be hit.w.nihi.in.w.x -- "their horses."

(But if it's just one horse--?)

hit.w.nih.w
