(If the Pawnee brought the tobacco to the Wichitas, and you got it untied, would you pass it around?)

Like I say, that if it's accepted, I would say well, I give fifteen twenty dollars, I untie the tobacco, and I be the man that smoke, start smoking that tobacco. It signify that it's accepted.

(Do other people smoke too?)

Yes.

(Is it just the people who make contributions that smoke?)

Anyone could smoke if they offer it to you.

(You've done that for this year, that is taken the tobacco to the Pawnees?)

That was last year. But Pawnees will come down this year. They'll be down here three weeks, I understand.
