8 checkerboarded, you mean by ownership?

9 THE COURT: Yes.

10 MR. KAMINS: Yes, it is.

11 THE COURT: There is government
12 ownership, there is individual ownership, and there is
13 Interior Department purchased in trust for the Cherokees.
14 Three different types of ownership.

15 MR. KAMINS: Yes. And
16 possibly one other type.

17 THE COURT: Well, maybe one
18 other.

19 MR. KAMINS: But, basically
20 there are these three.

21 THE COURT: Yes. All right,
22 and this is checkerboarded.
