11 THE COURT:

Yes.

12 MR. KAMINS:

Yes, it is.

13 THE COURT:

14 There is government
15 ownership, there is individual ownership, and there is
16 Interior Department purchased in trust for the Cherokees.
17 Three different types of ownership.

18 MR. KAMINS:

19 Yes. And
20 possibly one other type.

21 THE COURT:

22 Well, maybe one
23 other.

24 MR. KAMINS:

25 But, basically
there are these three.

THE COURT:

Yes. All right,
and this is checkerboarded.
