that had been purchased by the government for -- in trust for the Cherokees. But, your point is that Mr. White thought he did and it was Section 32 as far as he was concerned?

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- 5 MR. KAMINS: Yes, and I think 6 Nr. White would be better qualified to point because it. 7 was the map -- the maps and overlays that we were using 8 were prepared by Mr. White and he saw the direction when Mr. Chewie pointed from the point of arrest and 9 identified the direction in which he was pointing and the 10 11 location -- the general location of the arrest being 12 within Section 32, and that appears in the transcript. 13 I could get the citation. 14 THE COURT: No. that's all 15 right. 16 **HR. KAHINS:** But it does appear 17 in the transcript. 18 THE COURT: I agree with you, 19 Hr. White said that. I'm talking about what I observed. 20 MR. KAMINS: Now, if Mr. Chewie 21 was pointing on the map in a different direction. I don't 22 know whether we clarified whether Mr. Chewie understood the overlay on the map or not and the directions on the 23 . 24 map. I think he did, as THE COURT:

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
