2 THE COURT: Well, it is in
3 trust. You are agreeing it was bought in trust.

4 THE WITNESS: Parts of it.

5 THE COURT: For the Cherokees.

6 THE WITNESS: Yes.

7 THE COURT: You say parts of
8 it. What part isn't?

9 THE WITNESS: Well, in each
10 section, as you pointed out to the court awhile ago,
11 there are the -- the ownership is checkerboarded.

12 THE COURT: Yes.

13 THE WITNESS: And certain parts
14 were purchased by the United States in trust for the
15 Cherokee Tribe. There are other portions of Section 32
16 which apparently are unrestricted and there are portions
17 of Section 32 in which title is just in the name of the
18 United States.

19 THE COURT: And there is some,
20 when you say unrestricted, that belongs to individuals.

21 THE WITNESS: Yes. Not under
22 our supervision.

23 THE COURT: Right.

24 Q (by Mr. Trapp) Within Section 32,
25 21, 23, Mr. Daugherty --
