2 BY MR. O'BRYAN:

3 Q Mr. Daugherty, as I understand your
4 testimony at the present time you are trying to tell us
5 that the federal government has some interest in the land
6 where this particular act may or may not have taken place,
7 is that not correct?

8 A Yes, the land in Section 32.

9 Q Now, if this particular act took place in
10 Section 32, referring directly to it, was this land ever
11 a part of the State of Oklahoma?

12 A I don't have the entire title history of
13 the property. Now, I know that some of these tracts belong
14 to individuals and were acquired from individuals, but
15 I don't know the history of the tracts from allotment until
16 the time they were acquired by the government.

17 Q Well, is it possible, then, that some of
18 those lands in Section 32 out there could have been
19 lands that belonged to the State of Oklahoma and were
20 simply purchased --

21 MR. KAMINS: Your Honor, we
22 will object to that because Mr. Daugherty answered he
23 doesn't have any chain of title.

24 THE COURT: Well, he can
25 answer too. There have been more or less a lot of leading
