

1 "a dependant Indian community." We have a dependent
2 Indian community because we have testimony that the
3 average annual income is \$500 in that area. We also --
4 also allotted land is Indian country and the statute
5 clearly says that Indian country is under the sole
6 jurisdiction of the federal court and not under the state
7 of Oklahoma.

8 Now, we have given three -- there are four sections
9 of that statute and we have given testimony to support
10 three sections that this is Indian country, it has been
11 Indian country, it has been for the use and benefit of
12 the Cherokees, and this court has the jurisdiction if
13 something occurs on the land. If a member of the tribe,
14 and there is no question, this was never raised that
15 Johnnie Chewie was not a full blood -- we entered the
16 roll numbers of his natural father and mother, that he
17 is a person who is eligible for all the immunities,
18 privileges and benefits of the tribal acts and the
19 treaties.

20 THE COURT: Mr. Kamins, now,
21 you are wasting your time and mine too. I agree that
22 sounds good. That sounds wonderful.

23 But, what I am talking about is under the Indian
24 country definition, then, why does he have a right to
25 fish and hunt without regard for the state laws? You
