the establishment of the monetary amount is not necessary, 1 but for the purposes of the record, if the court intends 2 to base its ruling, in whole or in part, in that amount 3 we would like to have an opportunity to at least introduce, 4 at sometime, some evidence as to that so it cannot be 5 ruled against us that we just failed to do it. 6 THE COURT: Well, Mr. Ringold. 7 you asked me if the court intends to weigh that. What 8 option does the court have? I don't know of any option 9 the court has but to consider the \$10,000. 10 Well, I would say, MR. RINGOLD: 11 too, --12 THE COURT: Well, you failed 13 on the first one, certainly. I see no conflict at all. -14 I just got through saying that. All I asked you to do 15 was give me the name of the treaty. 16 We wish we could. MR. RINGOLD: 17 THE COURT: All right. Sò 18 there is none. All right. 19 So, I must look at something for jurisdiction and 20 I haven't heard anything yet establishing jurisdiction 21 in this court. 22 MR. RINGOLD: LWell, we have . 23 an honest difference of opinion on that particular phase 24 of it. 25
