But, that doesn't matter if there is an injustice, but you have your remedy. If the court has ruled improperly you can go to the Tenth Circuit. But, I do not see where you have established any jurisdiction in this court at all, and I'll have to make my ruling at this time because-I have other matters I must continue.

The court will state that this court lacks of jurisdiction. Thère has been no proof that there is any conflict between the constitution or laws or treaties in the United States and the state law.

Secondly, if it considered the \$10,000 amount there has been no proof at all as to the \$10,000 amount being involved.

No proof was ever made that a treaty giving Indians in Oklahoma hunting and fishing rights nor that lands involved was an Indian reservation, so there is no conflict there.

Neither was there any proof as to damages suffered because of denial of the right to hunt.

Now, under Rule 12(h)(2), where the court lacks jurisdiction of the subject matter the court will dismiss this action.

There are some cases, if you would like, that I can give to you to support this.
