That's Eva Luther. She's Caddo. And she made me a apron, oh, it's all faded. Everything I got, people give to me. I don't know why. But, I guess it's because I'm so poor. I got a trunk full of shawls and blankets—every one of them been given to me. She told me she had a design, I told her I liked this one. She told me, I'm going to make you a pillow top. And I'm not even using it, i 's too pretty to sit on.
