

(Three-fourths of eighty acres.)

And half of it went to these other kids. That's when Carrie Lee come in and Imogene come in--after the death of their father they come in on it. That's the way it was, and Rosie. I have no part. Their kids (have it). His daughter gets his share, and Rosie's two kids get their get their share, and her husband--three of them on her share.
