always just be fifty-eight cents." "Well, give me fifty cents," she said.

I had four dress goods and a quilt and a pound of coffee and five pounds of sugar! Jessie Birdshead told them, "This woman come over here and rob that poor old lady!" (How did you get the dress goods?)

I gave her a dollar for them. They were all four yards (in length). A dollar apiece (for each four-yard length). And I used to beat her in the game!
