BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

William Sutton was born in 1896. He lives east of Canton, Oklahoma, and is supposed to be one of the few Indians left in the area who went to school at old Fort Cantonment, which is northeast of Canton about three miles. He attended Cantonment school for about seven years and Chilocco for seven years.
