you ain't nothing--in my book. And I split my ticket, we get some sorry fellers in office, but I don't put my--you have to put 'em out. So I had lottsa--but it was pretty tough.

## MORE BACKBROUND MATERIAL:

(Didn't you tell me you were part Indian?) \

Lim Cherokee. .. My mother was a educated woman; she -- my father was undeducated, but my mother had a pretty good education. And my dad was jest an apen hearted man, youknow, and I -- she had a uncle that was on the Dawles commission. I think his name was Cox. And dad thought this was always be a big open country, you know. Never thought this was always be a big open county you know. Never thought nothing about a\_state, because it left Texas, because it was a state. Came into Indian territory and (unintelligible) held land on a million miles--brother and sister. There's three of us. Their both dead. But, that was one mistake he rake but, he made several of 'em. He got oil field down there by Fox by Alvea, Oklahoma Feller day a water well there and he went 250 feet and struck gas, but no water. So he had to quit. And (unintelligible) fixed it up where he could set it afire and it'd curn. ///and finally oil man come down messed around and of course they dug down alout a thousand feet and seen what was there and so they fest set the well down. I be didn't have what was there so they didn't have enough business sense to hold the royalty, og that place and he wold the place at a very reasonable price and estable he gother ay from there I don't know how many -- he's got four or five oil well on there. Well, you see, he made a distable there. Depple in the early day, they like know how to do business. And the fellow that knew how to do business some on pr Kansas and Missiouri, Mentucky later years, you know. You take the feller that or in here--he was an undducated han, all he knew was to jest work and if he has soot Juck and rised cattle and cattled was so cheap you douldn't make a living or You could buy s-faalf for ten dollers and maybe Beefs for five and seven doll . . Same cow today would bring you 3150, 3200, see. But, we got along fairly well. But, my dad had to pread and they had to pay him in chips and wetstone.
