(Mmmm-hmmm.)

And, heck, the Wichitas used to use this Horn Dance too, (not clear).

We don't use that any now. I seen two, I think. I told them, "I just know two songs." I wanted to see if they dance that way, you know.

(Yeah.)

I seen them. Last year, they must have got a dance there. They're--well, the Comanches used to use it, you know, Horn Dance.

(Did they?)

Yeah, and (pause) let's see, well, they did--I think they use Stomp Dance.

Well, I think that's about all of the dances, but we don't use them any more.

FIRE DANCE - WORSHIP

(Yeah. You were telling me a little bit the other day about this Fire Dance.)

Yeah.

(Could you tell--)

It's not--it's not Fire Dance.

(Yeah.)

It's a--it's a (pause)--well, the way I could explain, it's not a dance, you know.

(Yeah.)

Nobody dances. It's a worship.

(I see.)

Worship for sin, you know, among our tribe.
