(Oh really)

Uh-huhr

(Don't they sort of come in and stay for awhile and then leave?)

Uh-huh.

(...and then come back?)

Uh-huh...yeah. They dance for awhile and then--I don't know why they get out and then they leave and then come back again.

(Seems like there's always people coming and going. But do the singers generally stay there all night?)

Uh-huh, the singers usually stay there all night and there are a few new ones that come in and sing for a while. And I have noticed here lately that they take out time for breaks.

(Oh they do?)

Then they stand around and smoke.

(They just have sort of a rest period.)

Uh-huh. I just seen that done last summer. That's the first time I seen it done was last summer.
