velp, they holler. "Everybody..we're going to have a Sundance, we're going to have a Sundance." Then they all know that the Sundance is coming. Next summer. So, when that Sundance coming the people get They get their clothes ready, the clothes that they are going to wear. Buckskin clothes and all those fine clothes, and they save the horses, the good horses that they gonna ride during that time. Everything they get ready. All right. Now, next spring comes. They look forward to a leader. He is in charge of that medicine. He's got a medicine. It's red like doll or something. And they call him Tai-me. His name is Tai-me. And they think a whole lot of him. They think he's got a powerful...they think he's good medicine. So when that spring comes it's getting up into June or July, somewhere along in there.. Maybe early part. The people are looking forward to this man. He is a leader They call him Tai-me-do.. Keeper. He is the medicine keeper. They look forward to him and he knows it. And just about time he moves on. broke or move his camp somewhere. The people saw him..he's done move. The Indians say the Tai-me, Keeper..they medicine man already move to a new camp. He was getting ready. Well, the people pack and get ready to move. The Indians are dragging the tipi poles. They dragging everything what they could use over there. Then they come to his camp. Not only/one big bunch of them. They camp all the way around. All right, this man he sit there..he smoke. He smoke his medicine pipe. He is talking to his medicine God. He talk to him. He pray to him. He tell him, "We are going to have Sundance." He says, "I want you to take it up and carry it on a good ways. No harm no sickness no death, everything ought to be carried in a good order. Everybody well and everybody happy."
