that's way back. Something like about 1817 my Grandpa was a young man. That was his Sundance when he get up to old enough to know that was his Sundance. That's the one he was telling me where he had one Sundance, he had to name that Sundance. Another one over here, all this and that There is lots to tell. Yeah, I know Grandpa 1817, he join to the Blackfoot before that he was a Rabbit, Tabbit clan, little boy. Now when he grew up in 1817 they took him up on this Blackfoot.

Mrs. H: Can you start with that No Arm River?

Mr. G.: HU?

Mrs. H.:Starting from 1863.

Mr. G., Yeah, yeah, the Sundance is a..let's see the Sundance. There is one Sudnace I'm tyying to remember.

Mrs. H: 1883 is that NO Arm River Sundance. (She meant 1863.)

Mr. Yeah.

Mrs. H: That's the first one you ususally start out with.

Mr. G. (Speaking in Kiowa.) That's one they call em Cat Tail Sundance.

You know them some kind of a plant that grows in water, they call them

Cattail. Sundance.

(Do you remember what year that was?)

Mr. G. I belive it/was 1883. I think. Then the next one is Weed Sundance.

Mrs. H: Ragweed.

Mr. G. (Kiowa) Then.

Mrs. H.: What year Grandpa, you use to know the years.

Mr G.: It's uh...

Mrs. H: 1863 was that No Arm River and the next one you said was Ragweed.
