(Where did the Kiowas first get it?) What? (Peyote?)

Oh, way back they use to eat with different with different tribes. Not only all of them but just one, two, three Kiowas. Then they come, coming coming pretty soon they just come. Yeah, they think it is a god or something. I find out when you get in there you find out yourself, it's nothing.

(Where did the Kiowas find out about it?) Th

They find out from the Caresa..some bribe of they call them Caresa.

They some kind of maybe Mexican or I don't know. They found this peyote

I don't know how they found it and they eating it use it in worship.

And the Kiowas are drawn in there with them and that's the way they learn

it. You savy. Then the Kiowas go down there. Then the Comanches got

in there. Then that's the way it started, in my time, my young days.

They are peyote. They eat over here, at night time you could hear the

drum, another one over there yeah,

(Did your Grandfather use peyote?)
