(When's he going to have it, Joe?) Sunday. (This next Sunday?) . Then, following Sunday, there's a woman giving a dinner for her uncle. They're Pawnees. Pawnees, you know, they're different. She's giving kind of a feast like (Yeah.) On the fourth, and they're going to have it over here on the fourth. (Fourth of August.) Huh? (On the Fourth of August?) Yeah. (Yeah, yeah.) So, we're kind of pretty well tied up. (Boy, I'll say.) See, we were supposed to, well, there's a boy notified me a long time ago, you know. They, they, I don't know. You see, it's just people, you know, telling us. But I went down there, and my sister told me little about it. This Mac White Horse, I think they re trying to, oh, trying to get one of
