Like, you know, two that start the game, you know, and that one -- well, she lose, you know, they get them back again and they go, and they give it to anybody, you know, just like that, you know.

(Yeah.)

But this other way, Wichita regular game, you know, they all, you know, chosen kind, you know, line up, you know. Who's going to lead. You don't know, you know. They'll call your name. It's your time to hit, you know. But this other way, the way they play, you know, they just give it to anybody, you know.

(Yeah, yeah. )

Then, get up and hit, you know. But our ways, you know, we -- when they start, you know, they just start the two, and they don't, they don't, maybe a set of one game is over, there's second game, they'll get up and hit again, you know, the two again.

(Yeah.)

They just go on, you know. They know, you know.

(Yeah.)

They take them over there, you know, when -- when it's their time.

(Yeah, yeah.)

It's -- Pawnees have little different -- we pay Pawnee style.

(Yeah, I know, yeah.)

Yeah, we play Pawnee style.

(What's -- what are those pieces called that you hide in Wichita?) (Wichita Indian word.)

(Huh?)

(Wichita Indian word.) That's a bead.

(Oh, (Wichita Indian word) means bead?)
