ones got to guess where it's out, and them shoes -(Oh, they put the bead inside?) Yeah. (I see.) I didn't see them play long, you know. They -- I guess they used to play, you know, kind of moccasins. (Yeah.) You know. (Yeah.) Moccasin, we call it Moccasin Game. (Did the Wichita play that?) Well, I wouldn't know, you know, but I see that old man, He play --(Yeah.) -- like Moccasin Hand Game, look like, you know. (Yeah.) I didn't see them play long, you know. (Yeah.) They just -- they must both laugh, you know. You know, I guess they had lot of fun, you know. This man was Lomanche, you know. (Yeah.) ARROW THROWING GAME . That's about all the games I know, you know. Oh, yeah, I forgot this arrow --I don't know whatever, you know, they call it. I think (Wichita Indian word), "something like javalin, you know, but they make their arrows about that long, you know.

(Yeah.)

They throw them, you know. I guess the one that could throw the farthest,
