They just put it there to show he was wearing that blanket when he was killed.

(Was it a museum maybe?)

In a museur.

(A zoo is where they keep all those animals?).

They had animals and a museum and everything like that in that place up there...everything you know. That's where it was.

(You said the Indian name you had was Swa-ma-tica?)

Yes.

(How would you greet somebody in Comanche? To say "hello" or "how are you?")

Oh, there are so many ways. I don't know. Which one be the best one to say to anybody. But now days we don't even talk Indian to our folks to your house. Always be talking English.

(You talk Comanche a lot with Joey?)

Yes. I talk to Joey because he don't understand some words. He said he never did hardly go to school when he was a boy. His eyesight got bad.

((She said, when questioned about the meaning of her name, that she received it from her uncle after she was cured of a bad sickness.

It means "Thoughts are Passing."))
