But tis other one, he wanted to go back home, skin this other buffalo first and then take him back home. Oh, he was about two days. Kept walking around, you know, and this fellow he was kind of half crazy you know, and that's why they kind of left him off. When he got back home, why this fellow when they dance you know he thought he was a big shot you know and the other fellows said, "Now you lay down over here and we dance." So he lay down and all these other fellows danced, and then they just step on him you know cause his brother was gone, that's why they put him on the ground and danced stip on him, because his brother was gone you know. Oh, sometimes in the early morning this fellow went back and looked for his brother. He started off and took his horse with/him and find his brother still walking around that buffalo, you know. With the brush, you know. He brought him home, they got home right after-about dark, you know, they all was going to start dance again. So he cut a stick about as big as my cane, you know, he said, "When the dance going on tonight, you come over tonight. When they dance you know if they do anything with/me, get in there and whip all them people in there." So
